AFRO DESCENDANTS HOUSE IN YAOUNDÉ

KOUNCHOU FEZE is the promoter of this project and wants to open the doors for construction from February to December 2021. This ecological house will accommodate all Afro descendants born outside Africa south of the Sahara. It will be built in the style of Moroccan Riad, as an oasis with interior courtyard and would be baptized as “**RIAD of Brotherhood**”. The promoter invites African brothers and sisters to duplicate this initiative in several cities and villages of the continent.

Reconnection in Love, fraternity, generosity and communion.

This project is related to the policies in some African countries such as Ghana and more recently Gabon, which has adopted the right of return for Afro-descendants. KOUNCHOU FEZE's passion, compels him to bring the voice of Africans beyond words. He calls for a spirit of co-creation with his brothers and sisters to join his family to build a home for Afro descendants on the continent. The purpose is to ensure that the Afro descendants reconnection with brothers and sisters born outside the continent may be made in love, brotherhood and generosity and that they may feel at home and share a spirit of communion in connection to the ancestral roots. In creating this initiative, KOUNCHOU FEZE tries as much as possible to remove the possibility of this reconnection from the field of merchandising (Economy of Tourism).

Who can stay at the “RIAD of Brotherhood”?

By making the choice of inclusive property beyond the family circle, The KOUNCHOU family will open the 9 rooms provided for guests in their home to all Afro descendants born outside Africa south of the Sahara who have no identified family on the continent for free. The doors will also be open to all co-heirs of the World without distinction of race, religion, gender etc. they could stay at the House by paying a counterpart.
